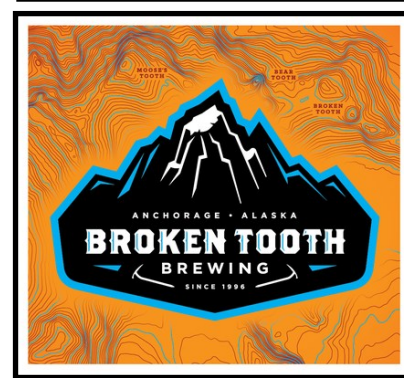
## Rules of Silent Auction

1. The silent auction begins at 5:30 PM.
2. Section A (red tables) closes at 7:45pm followed by the Section B (Blue tables) at 8:00pm and finally Section C (Yellow tables) & the Wine Auction (Gold tables) close at 8:15pm.
3. Bidder #s are used for all Auctions—Live, Dessert, Wine and Silent. Use legible writing and bid card number to place bid.
4. Bids increase in \$5/\$10/\$25 increments unless otherwise noted. An increased bid of LESS THAN the written bid increment will be disqualified and the bidder that has the next high bid will win.
5. Bid sheets are closed at the times stated and all highest written bids are FINAL. Any persons in the actual process of **writing** their higher bid, not waiting or approaching, will be granted the winning bid. Once the section is closed, all bid sheets will be validated.
6. The Chugiak-Eagle River Chamber requires that all items be paid for in full at the auction. Cash or credit cards are welcome. All sales are final. There are no refunds or exchanges. Your bidder number on bid sheets is a legal contract to buy.
7. When the last silent auction table closes the back room will be closed to guests. At that time, a checkout will be automatically processed for all guests with credit cards on file. A receipt will be emailed to you immediately to confirm if you won anything!
8. Check-out opens at 9:00 PM following the LIVE Auction. Please be patient as it takes time to process all of the bids. Guests may begin forming 2 lines, 1 at each door to the Silent Auction Room.
9. All items are to be removed from the premises on the night of the auction. Delivery service is not available. Make sure to pick up your gift cards and certificates at Item Checkout as most are not included inside the auction baskets themselves.
